

About the Women's Infrastructure Network

The Women's Infrastructure Network ("WIN") was established in 2010 from an interest expressed by women in the infrastructure industry to network and connect with peers across various disciplines.

WIN initially started in Toronto, Vancouver, Edmonton and Calgary. Since its founding in 2010, due to overwhelming interest, WIN has expanded to include chapters in Ottawa, Montréal, Saskatchewan, and Halifax, now including a membership base of over 2,500 individuals across Canada. Steering Committees across the chapters include some of the most senior women in infrastructure who have a keen interest in fostering networking and development of women in the industry.

WIN has evolved into a dynamic forum designed for women and allies of women in infrastructure to network, exchange ideas, and help shape the infrastructure agenda. Members represent a diverse group in the infrastructure industry, and include members of public agencies, equity sponsors, infrastructure and pension funds, commercial and investment banks, law firms, financial, technical and insurance advisory firms, engineering and construction firms, and operations and maintenance providers.

The WIN Awards






